Rosemarie has enjoyed creating Paper Tole works for over two decades and this exhibition displays her exceptional skills of shaping and sculpting the small pieces of paper to create realistic images.

Explore unseen objects in this unique exhibit of creative works by Evelyn Morrisson(Art of Evy). Evelyn believes “art is fun, and it provides an opportunity to not only relax but also to investigate the possibilities of creativity”. Trained in fine arts and graphics design Evelyn provides Gallery visitors with an opportunity to have a ‘hands on’ experience by touching many of the exhibits.

Larysa combines traditional artistic methods with digital tools, including animation and photography. Her exhibition includes one-off artist books given an extra life by making paperback version available.
