Entry Fee: \$20 per entry

Subject: Any Rural or Regional landscape

Medium: Any medium except photography

Section 3 – RURAL PORTRAIT AWARD

Award: \$500

Entry Fee: \$20 per entry

Subject: Any Rural or Regional portrait

Medium: Any medium except photography

Section 4 – RURAL ANIMAL AWARD (farm animals as well as Australian wildlife e.g. birds, fish, insects, mammals etc.)

Award: \$500

Entry Fee: \$20 per entry

Subject: Any Rural or Regional animal subject

Medium: Any medium except photography

Section 5– RURAL PHOTOGRAPHIC AWARD

Award: \$500

Entry Fee: \$10 per entry

Subject: Any Rural or Regional subject

Medium: Photography

Section 6– PEOPLE’S CHOICE AWARD

Award: \$500

Any subject, any medium from any category

JUDGING CRITERIA

All works need to depict a current rural scene, person, animal, or activity. i.e., not retrospective of early Australian rural life or scenes from an earlier time.

Work is to be created by an individual who lives in rural or regional Australia. This is defined as living in a regional council area as opposed to City Council boundaries.

Entries must be the original and unaided work of the entrant, completed before January 2024 (within the last 24 months as at 29th January 2024), and not having won a prize in any art competition, excluding Rural Agricultural Shows.

COMMISSION

All entries must be for sale.

Commission 20% - payable to the Kingaroy Arts Team Inc.

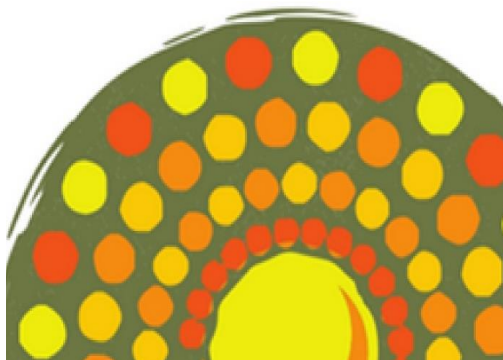
NOTE: Gallery Hours, Monday to Friday 10:00am to 4:00pm and 9am to 1 pm weekends. No deliveries / collections will be accepted out of these times.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Limit 2 entries per section, per person
2. Entry is open to any Australian resident who resides in a rural or regional area. This is defined as living in a regional council area as opposed to City Council boundaries.
3. Entries must be the original and unaided work of the entrant, completed before January 2024 (within the last 24 months as at January 29 2024) and not having won a prize in any art competition, excluding Rural Agricultural Shows.
4. All works must be mounted and framed ready for hanging with large 'D' hooks, wire or cord. Stretched canvasses are considered framed.
5. Section One, Open Award is an acquisitive category. Chosen from judging category sections 2-5
6. All works are for sale. A commission of 20% applies to sold work. Please include this in your selling price. If you are represented by a Gallery the 20% commission is in addition to any commercial arrangement you have in place.
7. Clear identification must appear on the back of each entry, marked with artist's name, address, email address, telephone number, section, medium, title of work and price.
8. Works to be in 2D only. Size of works is limited to 1.5m in any direction, including frame.
9. An artist CV (min. 1 x A4 page) is to be submitted with the entry.
10. All expenses relating to insurance, delivery, packaging, posting, and transport are the responsibility of the entrant, including return costs. A repacking fee of \$5 per entry for sent items must be included in entry fees.
11. Delivery and collection of work as detailed. Uncollected work will be stored at KRAG at owner's risk. *Works not collected within three months become the property of the Kingaroy Arts Team Inc.*
12. All reasonable care will be taken with artworks, but Kingaroy Arts Team Inc. (KAT), Kingaroy Regional Art Gallery or the South Burnett Regional Council accepts no responsibility for loss or damage.
13. Work may be photographed without fee while on display, for publicity and documenting purposes only.
14. Due to limited space an attempt will be made to display all works, but KAT reserves the right without explanation not to hang all entries.
15. All entries complying with the conditions will be judged, and the decision of the judge is final and binding. The judge at their own discretion may decide not to present an award in any category. If any situation arises not covered by the conditions, it will be resolved by KAT within 30 days
16. Entry fees are non-refundable.
