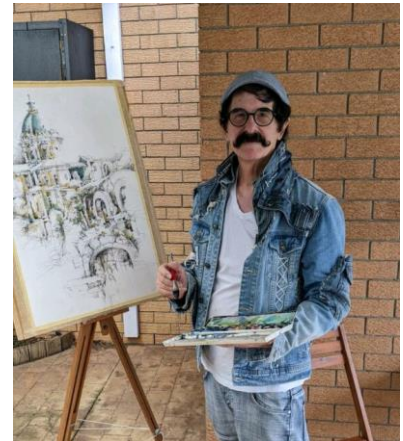
A 2 Day Urban/ Landscape Pen, Pencil Sketching and Colour Workshop
